The Summer Portal is designed with music as a common language and as an impetus to stimulate growth in a child's development.

Students audition either for the Choral Stream as singers in the Portal Choir or the Chamber Music Stream as instrumentalists majoring in piano, violin, viola, or cello. They receive intensive coaching by the faculty throughout the camp and perform at the Gala Concert.

Students not only learn about these values but also embody them, as guided by the Portal Guardian. GREATIVE PROBLEM SOLVING

Think-n-Speak, Think-n-Craft or Think-n-Design

What's more important than acquiring knowledge in today's Al age is developing skills that are transferrable. No attributes come more critical than creativity and problem-solving.

Students can choose from one of the three electives, through which to develop their critical thinking skills. While **Think-n-Speak** uses debating as forum, **Think-n-Craft** allows students to express through arts and craft and **Think-n-Design** explores design thinking with Al and multimedia tools.



SPORTS

Basketball, Table Tennis or Fencing

To promote a balanced lifestyle and boost endorphins, students can choose to participate in **basketball**, **table tennis**, or **fencing**, regardless of their experience or skill level.
